Tips for Accessing Library Resources Remotely

1. Use the **Library Hub** – <http://library.divinity.edu.au/>
The Library Hub provides access to thousands of online resources, ebooks, journals and other databases.
Use your University of Divinity ARK login email and password for remote access. If you have forgotten your password follow this [link](#)

4. Download the **Lean Library** browser extension - <https://library.divinity.edu.au/lean-library.html>
5. Students studying units at Catholic Theological College – Use the “Course Reserves” link at the top right of the **Mannix Library website** - <http://www.mannix.org.au/>
Clicking on the link for each unit will provide a list of all items on Reserve, and include a link to any items that are also available as an ebook.
6. Use the University’s **Alumni Services LibGuide** - <https://divinity.libguides.com/alumni>
This includes information about freely available resources. It also includes information about registering with the **State Library of Victoria** and the **National Library of Australia** so that you can also gain access to their eResources.
