Beginning with an historical, biblical and theological examination of the concepts of war and peace, it looks at pacifism and the early church, the development of the just war principles, the concept of “holy war”, a moral analysis of terrorism, and concludes with a critique of the adequacy of pacifist and just war thought as moral responses to the problems of contemporary conflict.
