


# Study at CTC

Continue your academic journey at CTC in Semester 2 with a host of exciting options, including:

### CT8010C Introduction to Theology

A journey into the study of theology in the Catholic tradition. Examine the meaning, purpose, method and content of Christian theology. Consider the following theological themes: God, revelation, theology and its sources, Jesus Christ, the reign of God and the Church. Reflect theologically on Christian faith in the context of a religiously diverse world.

### DT9021C Sexuality and Christian Discipleship

The context of this unit is the Catholic theological tradition. It proceeds on the basis that human sexuality concerns all aspects of the human person, permeating all human relationships and lifestyles. Explore the Catholic teaching on human sexuality in general, and consider the implications of this teaching for vocations such as marriage and family, for varied lifestyles, and for committed relationships. Grapple with social issues pertaining to sex and sexuality in contemporary society, as well as the nature and context of education in human sexuality.

### CH2/3/9200C The Church in Australia

Explore the history of the Catholic Church in Australia, examining its foundation and its development through its lay beginnings, its early Benedictine leadership and the rise of the Irish hierarchy. Some key issues will be the influence of sectarianism, the Church in the political environment and the influence of the religious orders in the Church's stance regarding education. Look at the changing role of the churches and religion in Australian society and examine the significance of church architecture, relations with indigenous cultures and the impact of migration.
